

North Fond du Lac man charged with sexually assaulting 10-year-old child

NORTH FOND DU LAC – A 57-year-old man is charged with sexually assaulting a 10-year-old child.

Ronald L. Shingleton was charged Monday with first-degree sexual assault — sexual intercourse with a child under age 13; first-degree sexual assault of a child under age 12; and first-degree sexual assault/sexual contact with a child under age 13, according to court records.

According to the probable cause affidavit, the child told the trained forensic interviewer that Shingleton inappropriately touched and sexually assaulted the child multiple times and told the child it was “punishment.”

Judge Dale English set cash bond at \$100,000, with the stipulation that Shingleton cannot have contact with the child, the child’s family or residence, or any child under 18.

A preliminary hearing is scheduled for May 10
