

**IMPORTANT PUBLIC
NOTICE!
WINTER PARKING
LAW IN EFFECT
EVEN WHEN THERE IS
NO SNOW!**



Between November 15th through March 15th, from 8 p.m. of an even calendar date to 8 a.m. the following day, parking shall only be permitted on the side of the street with even-numbered addresses. From 8 p.m. of an odd calendar date to 8 a.m. the following day, parking shall only be permitted on the side of the street with odd-numbered addresses.

Exception: Where parking is prohibited on one side of the street, parking shall always be in accordance with those regulations.

PENALTIES:

First violation: \$15.00 if paid within five (5) days. After 5 days, but within 28 days: \$30.00.
Second violation: \$30.00 if paid within five (5) days. After 5 days, but within 28 days: \$45.00.
Third violation: \$50.00 if paid within five (5) days. After 5 days, but within 28 days: \$65.00.
Fourth and subsequent violations: \$100.00. Additional penalties may apply: If any parking ticket is not paid within 28 days from the date of issuance, the Village will make application to the Department of Transportation in accordance with Wisconsin State Statutes to suspend the vehicle's registration and refuse to renew registration of any and all vehicles registered to the violator. Such suspension shall be in effect until such time that the Village gives written notice to the Department of Transportation that the forfeitures imposed have been satisfied.

SNOW EMERGENCIES ARE DIFFERENT:

***DURING THE TIME OF SNOW EMERGENCY AS DETERMINED BY
THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICES,
ALL VEHICLES WILL BE MOVED OFF THE STREETS FOR THE
PERIOD OF THE SNOW EMERGENCY.***

***Failure to adhere to A SNOW EMERGENCY will result in citation and
towing of vehicles, at owners expense.***
